**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC), Lewis County, Washington, has reviewed Memorandum of Understanding, #141P6226-COVIDVAC, between Lewis County and Valley View Health Center; and

**WHEREAS**, funding is provided by Valley View Health Center in the amount of \$300,000.00 ; and

**WHEREAS**, funding will provide testing strike teams and administer COVID-19 vaccines to residents of Lewis County from January 21, 2021 through April 21, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears to be in the best public interest to authorize the execution of said contract for Lewis County.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that MOU between Valley View Health Center and Lewis County in the amount of \$300,000 from January 21, 2021 through April 31, 2021 to provide testing strike teams and administer COVID-19 vaccines to residents of Lewis County is hereby approved and the Director of Public Health & Social Services is authorized to sign the same.
