**WHEREAS**, the Director of Information Technology Services has identified the need for replacement hardware and upgraded software to meet the County's dispatching and records needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) has granted department heads the authority to bind the county in amounts totaling \$50,000 to \$350,000 with BOCC approval, as outlined in Resolution No. 23-232.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Information Technology Services, or his designee, to complete a purchase order with Motorola Solutions, as per the attached quote, to proceed with the hardware and software refresh for \$318,715.00 plus applicable taxes.
