WHEREAS, the Lewis County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) appoints individuals to serve on the Pacific Mountain (PacMtn) Workforce Development Council; and

WHEREAS, the BOCC appointed Peter Lahmann to the PacMtn Workforce Development Council for a three-year term expiring June 30, 2021, via Resolution 18-202 and reappointed him for a three-year term expiring June 30, 2024, via Resolution 21-133; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best public interest to reappoint Peter Lahmann to the Pacific Mountain Workforce Development Council.
