**AMENDMENT NO. 1**  
**TO AGREEMENT NO. RCO #15-1475**  
**LEWIS COUNTY**

**Purpose**

The purpose of this amendment is to amend the statement of work and increase the project budget for the additional work items added to the scope.

Contract #15-1475 by and between the RECREATION AND CONSERVATION OFFICE (RCO) and LEWIS COUNTY is amended as follows:

**STATEMENT OF WORK**

Lewis County shall provide the following services to RCO related to flood hazard reduction in the Chehalis Basin and in support of the Chehalis River Basin Flood Authority:

1. Flood Authority will track the progress of local capital projects funded by the Legislature to reduce flood damage and improve aquatic species habitat including installation, calibration and emergency repair of Flood Warning System gages and associated instrumentation. It will advise RCO on the suitability of local projects prior to RCO issuing contracts to project sponsors. The Flood Authority will support project sponsors by helping coordinate the involvement of regulatory agencies. Where appropriate, it will review alternative designs and provide input to the project sponsors and RCO on how best to meet the intent of the Legislature.
  
5. Deliverables to be submitted to RCO by the Flood Authority will include the following:
  - General work plan(s), schedules of deliverables, and associated documentation and materials once established by the Flood Authority.
  - Copies of recommendations to the Governor's Chehalis Basin Work Group.
  - Brief status reports (including expenses itemized by budgetary item) to be submitted with each invoice, describing progress related to the work under this agreement, including activities and expenditures associated with State Auditors Office review and reporting.
  - Copies of recommendations regarding capital projects funded by the Legislature.

**COMPENSATION**

RCO shall reimburse Lewis County, acting as the Lead Agency for the Chehalis River Basin Flood Authority ("Flood Authority"), an amount not to exceed five hundred two thousand six hundred nineteen dollars and nineteen cents (\$502,619.19), including any applicable tax and indirect costs, for the performance of all things necessary for, or incidental to, the work as set forth in this Agreement.

Allowable costs shall include costs incurred by the Flood Authority from the first date of the Agreement period until the Agreement is terminated or expires as provided herein, but in no event shall allowable costs exceed the maximum amount of the Agreement. Costs allowable under this Agreement are based on the following agreed budget.
